- Web site is open. Everything posted
- Anyone can participate in work
 - Individual members vote
 - Contributor agreement required
- Managing Sponsors participate in governance
- Advocate Sponsors represent communities
- Liaisons with SDO's are standard liaisons

Contributor Grant of License to LETSI. Contributor grants to LETSI and to all other parties that have access to the Contributions a nonexclusive, worldwide, perpetual, royalty-free license to use, modify, prepare derivative works of, publicly display, publicly perform, sublicense and distribute in any manner the Contributor's Contributions to LETSI Development Efforts.

Copyright and License of LETSI Work Products. All LETSI Work Products shall be licensed and distributed in manner consistent with the principles and operating procedures approved by the Board of Directors.

License of LETSI Software. LETSI Software shall be published and distributed under the "Simplified BSD License" approved on the 9th of January, 2008, by the Open Source Initiative (OSI) (Attachment A), or in the event that such license is revised or withdrawn by OSI, under a similar license that enables commercial and non-commercial use and is approved by OSI and the Board of Directors.

Non-Confidentiality of Information. All information exchanged under this Agreement shall be deemed non-confidential, except for (a) information explicitly designated as confidential; or (b) information acknowledged as confidential by the Board of Directors and disclosed pursuant to confidentiality terms accepted by the recipient and approved by the Board of Directors.
